AN ORDINANCE to amend the Industrial Training Ordinance, 1911.

[16th May, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industrial Training Short Title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

2. It shall be lawful for the Board of Industrial Training to establish, maintain and carry on an Institute for the training of the Blind, and the Industrial Training Ordinance, 1911, shall be read as if the establishment, maintenance and carrying on of such Institute as aforesaid were one of the duties imposed upon the Board by the said Ordinance. Board may maintain an Institute for the Blind.
