AN ORDINANCE to amend the Lepers Ordinance, 1913.

[26th May, 1916.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Lepers (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

Amendment of  
Section 9 of  
Ordinance  
32—1913.

2. Section 9 of the Lepers Ordinance, 1913, is amended by inserting the following as Sub-section (4) thereof:—

(4) The powers, rights and jurisdiction conferred and the fines penalties, liabilities and duties imposed by or under the provisions of sub-sections (1) and (3) of this section shall extend and apply to a case where a District Medical Officer receives or acquires information that any person residing within his district is a leper or shows symptoms

from which it may be reasonably inferred that he is a leper, in all respects as if such District Medical Officer had received a notice or certificate such as is in Sub-section (1) of this section referred to.

Passed in Council this Twenty-eighth day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
