AN ORDINANCE to amend the Montreal Trust Company's
Ordinance, 1915.

[11th April, 1916.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Montreal Trust Company should possess such additional powers as are conferred by this Ordinance and that for that purpose the Montreal Trust Company's Ordinance, 1915, should be amended in manner hereinafter appearing: Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Montreal Trust Short Title.
Company's Ordinance, 1916.

2. Section 3 of the Montreal Trust Company's Ordinance, Repeal.
1915, is hereby repealed and the following section shall be inserted in lieu thereof:—

3. The Company may—

(a.) Accept, fulfil and execute all such trusts as may
be committed to the Company either jointly with others or

separately by any person or any corporation on such terms as may be agreed upon or as the Court shall in case of disability approve.

(b.) Take, receive, hold and convey all estates and property both real and personal which may be granted, transferred, committed, conveyed or mortgaged to the Company with its assent upon any trust and deal with such property for all the purposes of such trust.

(c.) Be appointed, accept and hold the office, and perform all the duties of Trustee, Executor, Administrator, Receiver, Trustee for the benefit of creditors, Liquidator, Guardian of the person or property of an infant, or Committee of a lunatic when appointed thereto in the same manner as individuals are appointed to fill any such offices, and be appointed and delegated generally to act as agent for persons or corporations acting in any of the said capacities.

(d.) Stipulate for, collect, receive, sue for and recover all agreed or reasonable remuneration together with all legal, usual and customary costs, charges and expenses for all or any of the duties, trusts and services of any kind whatsoever rendered, observed, executed performed or done in pursuance of any of the powers of the Company, whether or not such duties or services are by law or custom gratuitous.
