AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Duties  
Ordinance, 1913 (No. 10.)

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

2. Section 13 of the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1913, is hereby repealed, and the Second Schedule to the said Ordinance is amended by striking out the words "Articles imported by or for the use of the Governor of the Colony" in the seventeenth line thereof.
