AN ORDINANCE to amend the Firearms Ordinance,
1909, (No. 9.)

[6th May, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

1909 to apply
to airguns.

2. The provisions of the Firearms Ordinance, 1909 shall apply to an air gun or any other kind of gun from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged, and shall be construed and have effect as if such air gun or other kind of gun as aforesaid were included within the definition of "gun" in Section 2 of the said Ordinance.

Passed in Council this Fourteenth day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
