AN ORDINANCE to amend the Income Tax Ordinance,
Ch. 33. No. 1.

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Income Tax (Amend-
ment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the
Income Tax Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal
Ordinance, and shall be deemed to have commenced and come
into force on the 1st day of January, 1948.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance, as replaced by the Income Tax (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1947, is hereby amended by the repeal of paragraph (2) thereof and by substitution of the following paragraph therefor :—

“(2) In the case of a Company other than a Life Insurance Company ...45 per centum.”

3. This Ordinance shall remain in effect until the 31st day of December, 1948.
