AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Councils Ordinance, 1946.

[6th May, 1948.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the County Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the County Councils Ordinance, 1946, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title. No. 18 of 1946

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (3) of section 68 of the Principal Ordinance, the term of office of every Councillor elected at the first general election held under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance shall, subject to the exceptions specified therein, continue until the 31st day of December, 1949.
