AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the method of computing the pension payable to Gilbert Roberts, a person employed in the Works and Hydraulics Department of the Colony, on his retirement from the service of the Government.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gilbert Roberts (Pension) Ordinance, 1948.

Short title.

Computation of pension payable to Gilbert Roberts.

2. For the purpose of computing the pension payable to Gilbert Roberts, an employee of the Works and Hydraulics Department, on his retirement from the service of the Government, the period during which he was employed by the Port-of-Spain Corporation prior to 1st May, 1947, shall be included in his pensionable service as though his service with the Port-of-Spain Corporation had been service with the Government.
