AN ORDINANCE to amend the Petroleum Office and Conservation Board Ordinance, Ch. 26. No. 1.

[25th November, 1948.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petroleum Office and Conservation Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Petroleum Office and Conservation Board Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :—

“Appropri-
ation.

10. The moneys raised under the Ordinance shall be paid into the general revenue of the Colony to defray the following expenses—

- (a) annual salaries of all persons appointed under this Ordinance ;
- (b) a contribution in respect of the pension rights (if any) of all persons appointed under this Ordinance ;
- (c) annual costs incurred and disbursements made in maintaining the Office ; and
- (d) all annual expenses incidental to the due administration of this Ordinance.”

Passed in Council this 29th day of October, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.
