AN ORDINANCE to amend the Agricultural Credit Societies Ordinance, Ch. 23. No. 4.

[25th November, 1948.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Agricultural Credit Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Credit Societies Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :—

“(2) The Director of Agriculture may utilise as he shall think fit the services of officers of his department for the purpose of carrying out the duties imposed upon him by this Ordinance, and may appoint any of such officers to be Inspectors of Societies registered under this Ordinance.”

Section 7
Principal
Ordinance
amended.

3. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words “an Inspector of Societies” for the words “the Inspector”.
