AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Authorities
Protection Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 3.Commence-
ment

[23rd December, 1948.]

Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

Ch. 9. No. 3

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Authorities
Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read
as one with the Public Authorities Protection Ordinance, here-
inafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. (1) No action shall be brought against any person for any act done in pursuance, or execution or intended execution of any Ordinance, or of any public duty or authority, or in respect of any neglect or default in the execution of any such Ordinance, duty or authority, unless it is commenced before the expiration of one year from the date on which the cause of action accrued :

Provided that where the act, neglect or default is a continuing one, no cause of action in respect thereof shall be deemed to have accrued for the purposes of this subsection, until the act, neglect or default has ceased.

(2) The foregoing provisions of this section shall not apply to any action to which the Principal Ordinance does not apply, or to any criminal proceeding.

(3) Paragraph (a) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed except in so far as it relates to criminal proceedings.

3. Nothing in this Ordinance or in the Principal Ordinance shall :—

(a) enable any action to be brought which was barred before the commencement of this Ordinance except in so far as the cause of action or right of action may be revived by an acknowledgment or part payment made ; or

(b) affect any action commenced before the commencement of this Ordinance or the title to any property which is the subject of any such action.

4. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "the execution of any such Ordinance" for the words "the execution of any such act".
