ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Aliens (Landholding) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Aliens (Landholding) Ordinance as amended by the Aliens (Landholding) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, which Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The expression "alien" when used in the Principal Ordinance shall, for the purpose of enabling the government of any foreign state to own land for consular use, but only in so far as it is necessary for such purpose, be deemed to include the government of any foreign state; and the relevant provisions of the said Principal Ordinance shall, subject to the aforesaid limitation, be construed accordingly.

The government of any foreign state authorised to own land for consular use.
