AN ORDINANCE to amend the Diplomatic Privileges
(Extension) Ordinance, 1947, No. 43 of 1947.

[21st April, 1949.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (Extension) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Diplomatic Privileges (Extension) Ordinance, 1947, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

2. The proviso to subsection (2) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following proviso:—

“Provided that the Order shall not confer upon any person as the representative of the Government in the Colony or as a member of the staff of such representative any immunity or privilege other than immunity from suit and legal process in respect of things done or omitted to be done in the course of the performance of his duties as a representative or as a member of the staff of a representative.”

Passed in Council this twenty-fifth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.
