AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a pension and gratuity to Mary Antoinette Pierre, former Wardsmaid at the House of Refuge.

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council therefor.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mary Antoinette Pierre (Gratuity and Pension) Ordinance, 1949.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Mary Antoinette Pierre, former Wardsmaid at the House of Refuge, in respect of her services as Wardsmaid a gratuity of three hundred and thirty-six dollars and a monthly pension, as from the 4th August, 1948, computed at the rate of one hundred dollars and eighty cents per annum.

Authority to pay gratuity of \$336 and annual pension of \$100.80 to Mary Antoinette Pierre.

Passed in Council this eighteenth day of November, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.
