AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of
a Widow's pension to Catherine Reid Ross.

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Catherine Reid Ross
(Widow's Pension) Ordinance, 1949.

2. There may be granted from general revenue to Catherine Reid Ross, widow of Robert Allan Ross, late Industrial Adviser for the Colony, a pension at the rate of seven hundred and thirty-two dollars and thirty-seven cents per annum as though the said Robert Allan Ross had become entitled to the privileges and benefits conferred by the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance upon contributors under that Ordinance permanently appointed to the public service of the Colony; and such of the provisions of the said Ordinance as are applicable, with the exception of subsection (3) of section 20 thereof, shall apply to the case of the said Catherine Reid Ross as though the pension granted to her under this Ordinance had been a pension granted to her under that Ordinance.

Authority to pay annual widow's pension of \$732.37 to Catherine Reid Ross.
