AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Councils
Ordinance, 1946.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the County Councils Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be read as one with
the County Councils Ordinance, 1946. No. 18 of 1946

Section 5 (1)
of Ordinance
No. 18 of 1946
amended.

2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the County Councils Ordinance, 1946, is hereby amended by deleting the words "in no case being more than three years after the date of the last preceding general election of members of County Councils,".

Section 68
of Ordinance,
No. 18 of 1946
amended.

3. Section 68 of the County Councils Ordinance, 1946, is hereby amended—

(a) by adding to subsection (3) thereof the following proviso :—

"Provided that the term of office of every Councillor elected at the first general election held under the provisions of this Ordinance shall, subject to the exceptions specified in this subsection, continue until the 31st day of December, 1950, and thereafter for a further period or periods of twelve months at a time by resolution of the Legislative Council." ;

(b) by repealing subsection (5) thereof and replacing it by the following subsection :—

"(5) On the next dissolution of the Legislative Council after the 1st day of January, 1950, paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of this section shall cease to have effect and each County Council shall, as soon as is convenient thereafter, appoint a Councillor to be Chairman of such Council. Each such appointment shall be for a period not exceeding twelve months but a Councillor may be re-appointed at the end of his term of office as such."

4. The County Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, is hereby repealed.
