1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Estate and Succession Short title
Duties (Killed in War) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946.

Amendment
of Section 2 of
Ordinance
No. 16 of 1944.

2. Section 2 of the Estate and Succession Duties (Killed in War) Ordinance, 1944 is hereby amended by the deletion of the definition of "the period of the present emergency" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the following definition:—

"the period of the present emergency" means the period beginning on the 3rd day of September, 1939 and ending on the 24th day of February, 1946.
