AN ORDINANCE to provide for the raising, levying and collecting of the House Rate by the Corporation of the City of Port-of-Spain at the rate of ten per cent. for the year 1946 and to provide for the date on which the Rate for the year 1946 shall be due and payable.

WHEREAS the House Rate for the City of Port-of-Spain is fixed by law at the rate of seven and a half per cent., but the Corporation is empowered by resolution to prescribe that in respect of any specified year or years the rate to be levied and paid shall be at a higher rate than seven and a half per centum;

And Whereas the Corporation omitted to prescribe by resolution for the rate higher than $7\frac{1}{2}$ per centum in respect of the year 1946:

And Whereas it has been deemed expedient to provide that the House Rate for 1946 shall be at the rate of ten per centum and to fix the date on which such ten per centum shall be due and payable:

Enactment.

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Corporation House Rate (Fixation) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be construed as one with the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

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House Rate
for year 1946.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 88 of the Principal Ordinance the House Rate for the year 1946 shall be at the rate of ten per centum per annum: Provided however, and be it further enacted:—

(a) The House Rate for the year 1946 shall, notwithstanding the provisions of section 100 of the Principal Ordinance, be due and payable on the 1st day of May, 1946, and shall be deemed to have been always due and payable on the 1st day of May, 1946.

(b) Nothing in this section shall prejudice the operation of section 119 of the Principal Ordinance.
