AN ORDINANCE to amend the Roads Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 1.

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Roads Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (1) of Section 50 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following subsection :—

“(1) The election of elective members of a Local Board shall take place on such day and at such place or places as the Governor may appoint by notice in the *Royal Gazette*.”

3. Section 90 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words “annual election” which appear in the third line thereof and by substituting therefor the words “election held under Section 50.”
