AN ORDINANCE to amend the Oil Mining and Refining Ordinance.

[31st December, 1946.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Oil Mining and Refining (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be construed as one with the Oil Mining and Refining Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by repealing the definition of "refinery" and replacing the same by the following :

"refinery" means any building or structure in the Colony used as an oil refinery or where any operations in and about the refining of oil or the extraction of petroleum spirit from natural gas are carried on.
