AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a reduced pension and gratuity to Rebecca Halkhoree former Assistant Teacher employed in various Canadian Mission Schools in the Colony.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rebecca Halkhoree (Gratuity and Reduced Pension) Ordinance, 1946.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Rebecca Halkhoree, former Assistant Teacher employed in various Canadian Mission Schools in the Colony, in respect of her service as Assistant Teacher a gratuity of seven hundred and thirty-two dollars and ten cents and a pension, as from the 1st January, 1946, at the rate of two hundred and ninety dollars and sixty-two cents per annum.
