AN ORDINANCE to amend the Plant Protection Ordinance,
Ch. 23. No. 16.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Plant Protection Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be read as one with Construction.
the Plant Protection Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Ch. 23. No. 16.

2. Paragraph (e) of section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "or suspected of harbouring any such thing" immediately after the word "disease".

Section 16 (1)

3. Subsection (1) of section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

"(1) The Plant Quarantine Station, Trinidad, shall be under the management of a Committee composed of the persons for the time being discharging the duties of—

- (a) Director of the Department of Agriculture ;
- (b) Entomologist and Mycologist on the Staff of the Plant Quarantine Station ;
- (c) Entomologist, Plant Pathologist, Sugar Agronomist, Chief Scientific Officer, of the Department of Agriculture ;
- (d) Principal, Head of the Department of Botany, of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture:

Provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council by notice in the *Royal Gazette* to remove any such person from, or appoint any other person as a member of, the said Committee."

Passed in Council this thirteenth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-six.
