**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Clubs Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with Ch. 32, No. 12  
the Registration of Clubs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as  
the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section :—

“15. Any commissioned officer of Police, and any constable appointed by him in writing to make inquiries for the purposes of this Ordinance, may, at any time during such hours as a registered club's premises are open to members, enter upon the premises and make inquiries for the purposes of this Ordinance and any commissioned officer of Police may call for and inspect all books and documents required to be kept on the premises and take copies of any entry in such books or documents.”
