AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a reduced pension and gratuity to Henry Bernard Kangaloo, former Assistant Master of Naparima Training College.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Henry Bernard Kangaloo (Gratuity and Reduced Pension) Ordinance, 1947. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Henry Bernard Kangaloo, former Assistant Master of Naparima Training College, in respect of his service as Assistant Master, a gratuity of two thousand four hundred and five dollars and a pension, as from the 12th January, 1947, at the rate of seven hundred and twenty-one dollars and fifty cents per annum.
