E NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1947, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January, 1947.



2. There may be issued and paid from and out of the Public Moneys of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the service of the year 1947, an amount not exceeding the following sums, that is to say :—
