AN ORDINANCE to amend the Assurance Companies Ordinance, 1943, No. 11 of 1943.

[6th March, 1946.]

Commence-  
ment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Assurance Companies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Assurance Companies Ordinance, 1943 as from time to time amended, which Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

2. Sections 9, 10, 32 and 33 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after the word "printed" wherever that word appears therein the words "or type-written".

Section 37 of  
Principal  
Ordinance  
amended.

3. Section 37 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting the following paragraph for paragraph (b) of subsection (1) :—

"(b) that the company has complied in relation thereto with the provisions of the law of the United Kingdom with respect to deposits and guarantees by, and minimum paid up share capital and margin of solvency of, assurance companies from time to time in force and applicable to such company," ;

(b) by substituting the words "law of the United Kingdom from time to time in force" for the words "Assurance Companies Act, 1909, or any Act amending or replacing the same" occurring in paragraph (b) of subsection (3).

Retrospective  
operation.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the 6th March, 1946.
