1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Port-of-Spain Corporation (Electricity) Ordinance, 1945, the Corporation shall not be the sole exclusive authority to supply electrical energy within any area leased to the Government of the United States of America in accordance with the Agreement between the Governments of the United Kingdom and the United States of America relating to the Bases leased to the United States of America and dated the 27th of March, 1941 : Provided always that it shall be lawful for the Corporation to enter into any contract for the supply of electrical energy for reward by the Corporation within any area so leased to the Government of the United States of America.

Passed in Council this sixteenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.
