AN ORDINANCE to amend the Oil and Water Board  
Ordinance, Ch. 26. No. 6.

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof.

[On Proclamation]

Commencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Oil and Water Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1944, and shall be read and construed as one with the Oil and Water Board Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short Title and

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on such date as the Governor may by proclamation appoint.

Section 30 of

2. Section 30 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words " the Director of Hydraulics and " between the words " satisfy itself that " and the words " all persons " occurring therein.

3. Section 44 of the Principal Ordinance shall cease to apply in relation to the construction of dams for the construction of which permits are required under the provisions of the Waterworks and Water Conservation Ordinance.
