AN ORDINANCE to amend the Control of Licensed
Premises (Temporary Provisions) Ordinance, 1943.

[27th April, 1944.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Control of
Licensed Premises (Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Control
of Licensed Premises (Temporary Provisions) Ordinance, 1943, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“Restrictions
on issue of
licences or
registration
of clubs.”

8. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no licence shall be granted or issued under the Liquor Licences Ordinance, and no registration shall be ordered or effected under the Registration of Clubs Ordinance unless the Commissioner of Police has certified that such licensing or registration would not be likely to be prejudicial to the maintenance of public order or the efficient prosecution of the war: Provided that, in the case of any premises situate within 200 yards of a church or school, a Magistrate shall not, although the Commissioner of Police has given a certificate in the terms mentioned above, grant a licence or order registration unless he is satisfied that for special reasons (to be recorded by him) such licence may be granted or registration ordered: Provided further that this section shall not apply to the issue of a licence in relation to any premises to a person already licensed in relation to those premises on the date of coming into force of this Ordinance or to the registering of a club already on the register on such date.”
