AN ORDINANCE to repeal the Emergency Taxation
Ordinance, 1939, No. 32 of 1939.

[30th December, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Emergency Short Title
Taxation (Repeal) Ordinance, 1943.

Repeal of the

2. The Emergency Taxation Ordinance, 1939 (being one of the Ordinances authorised by section 6 of the Law Revision Ordinance to be omitted from the Revised Ordinances, 1940), shall be deemed to have been repealed on the 1st of October, 1943, but without prejudice to the charging, levying and collecting of the oil impost provided for by section 3 of the Emergency Taxation Ordinance, 1939, in respect of any period prior to the 1st of October, 1943, or to any right, obligation or liability arising under the said section in relation thereto.
