AN ORDINANCE to amend the Cocoa Subsidy (Special
Taxation) Ordinance, Ch. 33, No. 9.

[30th December, 1943.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Cocoa Subsidy
(Special Taxation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943; and
shall be read and construed as one with the Cocoa Subsidy
(Special Taxation) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the
Principal Ordinance.

Section 2 of
the Principal

amended.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a new subsection (4) as follows:—

No. 25 of 1941.

“(4) This section shall remain in abeyance and be of no effect as regards any year of assessment to which subsection (1) of section 2 of the Income Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1941, relates, but shall be in full force as regards any subsequent year of assessment.”

Passed in Council this seventeenth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
