AN ORDINANCE for the incorporation of certain persons  
as TRUSTEES of LODGE ALEXANDRA, No. 1044  
S.C. of Freemasons in Trinidad.

[30th December, 1944.]

Commencement.

WHEREAS Donald Daniel Bissessar, Right Worshipful <sup>Preamble.</sup>  
Master of Lodge Alexandra of Freemasons in  
Trinidad, Garvin Montagu Scott, Worshipful Senior Warden  
and Alexander Roland Bynoe, Worshipful Junior Warden  
of the said Lodge Alexandra are desirous of being formed  
into a Corporate Body ;

No. 37. *Lodge Alexandra of Freemasons (Incorporated).* 1944.

And Whereas it is expedient that the said Donald Daniel Bissessar, Garvin Montagu Scott, and Alexander Roland Bynoe should be incorporated ;

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :--

- Short title.      **1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Lodge Alexandra of Freemasons (Incorporated) Ordinance, 1944.
- Incorporation of trustees.      **2.** Donald Daniel Bissessar and his successors in Office as Right Worshipful Master of Lodge Alexandra of Freemasons in Trinidad, Garvin Montagu Scott, Worshipful Senior Warden of the said Lodge, and Alexander Roland Bynoe, Worshipful Junior Warden, of the said Lodge and their successors in Office as Worshipful Senior and Junior Wardens of the said Lodge respectively, shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of " The Incorporated Trustees of Lodge Alexandra of Freemasons in Trinidad " and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall and may sue and be sued in all Courts of Justice in the Colony, and shall have and use a common seal which may from time to time be changed : Provided that no such change shall be made except by a resolution of the Members in open Lodge assembled.
- Trustees may acquire property.      **3.** The corporate body hereby created shall have full power to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance, or otherwise any real or personal property in the Colony or any estate or interest therein.
- Trustees may dispose of property.      **4.** The said corporate body shall, subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it shall have acquired title thereto, be entitled to sell, mortgage, lease, or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in or have been acquired by it.
- Vesting of property.      **5.** The parcel of land in the Town of San Fernando, in the Island of Trinidad, described in the Schedule to this Ordinance, with the buildings standing thereon, at present

held by Philip Theophilus Alexander Vilain in trust for the Members of Lodge Alexandra, shall be and the same is hereby transferred to and vested in The Incorporated Trustees of Lodge Alexandra No. 1044 S.C. of Freemasons in Trinidad in fee simple.

6. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of His Majesty, His Heirs or Successors, or of any bodies politic or corporate or any other persons except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Ordinance and those claiming by, through, from, or under them. Saving of Crown and other rights.

THE SCHEDULE

(Clause 5)

All and Singular that certain parcel of land situate in the Town of San Fernando, comprising three roods and twenty-one perches known as Lodge "Alexandra" and assessed as Nos. 34 and 36, Monchagrin Street, and abutting on the North partly upon lands of the Heirs of Taitt and others and partly upon lands of W. H. Nightingale; on the South partly upon a Road, partly upon lands of Lawrence and partly upon lands of N. Carter; on the East partly upon a Road, partly upon lands of W. H. Nightingale and partly upon lands of N. Carter; and on the West partly upon lands of the Heirs of Taitt and others, partly upon lands of Martin, partly upon lands of "Trinity" Lodge and partly upon a Road; which said parcel of land is delineated and coloured pink on a plan marked "A" annexed to a Deed registered as No. 4929 of 1935.

Passed in Council this fifteenth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-four.
