AN ORDINANCE to amend the Compulsory Education
Ordinance, Ch. 14. No. 2.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

[9th November, 1944.]

Commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Compulsory Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Compulsory Education Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“Application
of Ordinance.

3. This Ordinance shall apply to the whole of the Colony”

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words “for the purposes of this Ordinance” for the words “within Compulsory School Attendance Areas”.

Section 5 of

4. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“Duty of
parent to
send child
to school.

5. It shall be the duty of every parent of a child residing within two miles of a school to send such child regularly to a school or to provide such child with instruction, as efficient in the opinion of the Director of Education, as that obtainable at a school”.

5. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words “to whom the provisions of the last preceding section of this Ordinance apply” for the words “residing within a Compulsory School Attendance Area”.

6. Subsection (1) of section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words “within Compulsory School Attendance Areas” occurring in paragraph (c) thereof.
