AN ORDINANCE to amend the Law Officers Ordinance,
Ch. 7. No. 3.

[29th June, 1944.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Law Officers Short title
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1944, and shall be read as one Construction.
with the Law Officers Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance) Ch. 7. No. 3.

Section 5 of

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "the First Crown Counsel, the Second Crown Counsel" for the words "the Assistant Law Officer"; and by substituting the words "First Crown Counsel, Second Crown Counsel or such other counsel as may be appointed as aforesaid" for the words "Assistant Law Officer, or counsel".

3. (1) Part I of the Schedule to the Principal Ordinance, as amended by notice published in the *Royal Gazette* on the 29th January, 1942, is hereby further amended by deleting the words "Assistant Law Officer" and substituting the following:—

" First Crown Counsel
Second Crown Counsel "

(2) The preceding subsection shall be deemed to have had effect as from the 1st March, 1944.
