AN ORDINANCE to amend the Immigration (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1942.

[8th June, 1944.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration Short title.
(Special Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1944.

Section 4 of
Ord. 4 of 1942
amended.

2. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Immigration (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1942, is hereby amended by replacing the full-stop at the end thereof by a colon and adding the following proviso :—

“ Provided that this subsection shall not apply in the case of a female immigrant manual labourer who has, after entering the Colony, married a person deemed, for the purposes of the Immigration (Restriction) Ordinance, to belong to the Colony. ”

Passed in Council this nineteenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-four.
