AN ORDINANCE to amend the Registration of Clubs Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 12.

[15th November, 1945.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Clubs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Registration of Clubs Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title and

Section 24 of the Principal Ordinance repealed and replaced.

2. Section 24 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section :—

“ Savings as to canteens and messes.
Ch. 32, No. 11.”

24. Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Ordinance or in the Liquor Licences Ordinance shall be deemed to prohibit or restrict the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor to or in any Naval, Military, Air Force, Volunteer Force, or Police Force Canteen or Mess or other canteen or mess approved of by the Governor in Council, where the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor is carried on under the authority of the Governor.”

Passed in Council this twenty-sixth day of October, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
