AN ORDINANCE to amend the Estate and Succession Duties (Killed in War) Ordinance, 1944.

[29th March, 1945.]

Commencement.

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Estate and Succession Duties (Killed in War) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Estate and Succession Duties (Killed in War) Ordinance, 1944, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. (1) Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the words "other person killed in war" in the sixth line thereof the words "being the death of a person to whom that property or that part thereof passed on the earlier death."

(2) The foregoing amendment shall be deemed to have had effect from the date of commencement of the Principal Ordinance.
