AN ORDINANCE to make provision for defraying the expenses of the Government of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the year 1945.

[1st January, 1945.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1945, and shall come into force on the 1st January, 1945. Short title and commencement.

2. There may be issued and paid from and out of the Public Moneys of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the service of the year 1945, an amount not exceeding the following sums, that is to say:—
