AN ORDINANCE to amend the Poor Relief Ordinance.

E NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment. advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Poor Relief (Amend- Short title. ment) Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Poor Relief Ordinance, as amended by the Poor Relief (Amendment) Ch. 13, No 1. Ordinance, 1943, which Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter No. 45 of 1943. referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the definition of "Social Welfare Officer".

Section 4
of Principal

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) in subsection (2), by substituting the words "a Chairman and not more than eight other members, to be nominated by the Governor" for the words "the Director of Medical Services, who shall be Chairman, of the Social Welfare Officer who shall be Deputy Chairman, and of not more than eight other persons to be nominated by the Governor";

(b) by adding the following subsection immediately after subsection (2):—

"Acting
Chairman.

(2A) The members present at any meeting may, in the absence of the Chairman, elect any member to act as Chairman of such meeting."

(c) by substituting the following subsection for subsection (3):—

"Quorum.

(3) At any meeting of the Board any four members shall form a quorum, and the Chairman or acting Chairman, as the case may be, shall have a second or casting vote."

(d) by adding the following subsection at the end thereof:—

"Other
officers.

(5) The Governor may appoint such other officers as may be necessary for the purposes of this Ordinance at such salaries as the Governor, with the consent of the Legislative Council, may from time to time direct."

Section 15 of
Principal
Ordinance
amended.

4. Section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "and for any other officer appointed under the authority of this Ordinance" immediately before the words "to enter".
