AN ORDINANCE to provide for the payment to Bernard Westcott Turner-Smith of a pension of one thousand and eighty-eight dollars per annum.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment. advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bernard Westcott Short title. Turner-Smith (Pension) Ordinance, 1945.

Authority to
pay a pension
of \$1,088 per
annum to Ber-
nard Westcott
Turner-Smith.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Bernard Westcott Turner-Smith, retired Works Manager of the Trinidad Government Railways, in respect of his service with the Government, an annual pension of one thousand and eighty-eight dollars per annum as from the 26th day of October, 1944.

Passed in Council this ninth day of November, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
