AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Councils Ordinance, 1945.

[22nd November, 1945.]

Commence-
ment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment. advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Short title. County Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with No. 18 of 1945. the County Councils Ordinance, 1945, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the following paragraph for paragraph (a)—

“(a) he is registered as a voter for the electoral division for which he seeks election ; and”

Amendment
of section 21
of Principal
Ordinance.

3. Subsection (2) of section 21 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the following sentence for the first sentence appearing therein :—

“The first register shall be published on such date as the Governor shall order by notice in the *Royal Gazette*.”

Amendment
of section 29 of
Principal
Ordinance.

4. Section 29 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the following sentence for the first sentence thereof :—

“The first general election of members of the County Councils shall be held in such month in the year 1946 and on such date or dates as the Governor shall appoint by notice in the *Royal Gazette*.”

Amendment
of Registra-
tion Rules, &c.

5. (1) The Registration Rules contained in the Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of all provisions in respect of the year 1945.

(2) *Gazette Notice* No. 1150 published in the *Royal Gazette* of the 1st September, 1945, is hereby revoked and the publication thereunder of the lists of persons appearing to be entitled to be registered as voters is hereby declared to be null and void.

6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Principal Ordinance, the Governor may by notice in the *Royal Gazette* substitute any dates, whether in the year 1945 or the year 1946, for the dates specified in the Registration Rules contained in the Third Schedule of the said Ordinance in so far as is concerned the preparation and publication of the register of voters for the first general election of members of County Councils.

Chairman of

7. It is hereby ordained that so long as there are two members of the Legislative Council for the County of Victoria, the Chairman of the County Council for the Electoral District of Victoria shall be that member of the Legislative Council who was first elected to be a member of the Legislative Council for the said County.
