AN ORDINANCE to amend the War Loan Ordinance,
1941, and certain Regulations made thereunder.

[13th February, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the War Loan Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1943.

2. The War Loan Ordinance, 1941, shall have effect, Amendment of

and shall be deemed always to have had effect as if the
words "six million dollars" were substituted for the
words "four million eight hundred thousand dollars" No. 3 of 1941,
where the latter words occur in section 2 of that Ordinance.

Amendment
of the Savings
Certificates
(First Issue)
Regulations,
1941.

3. The Savings Certificates (First Issue) Regulations, 1941, published as a Supplement to the *Gazette Extraordinary* issued on the 19th of July, 1941, shall have effect, and shall be deemed always to have had effect, as if the following paragraph was substituted for paragraph (1) of regulation 2 thereof:—

Amounts authorised to be raised. 2. (1) The Governor may raise a sum not exceeding two million two hundred thousand dollars (being part of the total sum of six million dollars authorised by the War Loan Ordinance, 1941, to be raised) by the issue of Savings Certificates under these Regulations and the Savings Certificates (General) Regulations, 1941."

Passed in Council this twenty-ninth day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
