*Legislative Council (Special Provisions as to Register)*.

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the temporary postponement of the compilation of the next register of electors under the Legislative Council (Elections) Ordinance, Ch. 2. No. 2.

Commencement.

[31st December, 1942.]

Short title and construction.

Ch. 2. No. 2.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legislative Council (Special Provision as to Register) Ordinance, 1942, and shall be construed as one with the Legislative Council (Elections) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Postponement of compilation of new register.

2. The requirement of subsection (1) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance, in relation to the power of the Governor by proclamation from time to time to appoint the years in which registers are to be compiled, that any year so appointed shall in no case be more than five years after the date of the last preceding general election of members of the Legislative Council shall have no effect, and shall be deemed never to have had any effect, in respect of the period between the general election last preceding the commencement of this Ordinance and the first general election following the commencement of this Ordinance.
