Judicature (Amendment).

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Judicature Ordinance,
Ch. 3. No. 1.

[5th December, 1942.]

Commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Judicature Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title and construction.

Ch. 3. No. 1.

2. Section 43 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section :—

Section 43 of the Principal Ordinance repealed and replaced.

Approval and confirmation of rules.

43. Rules of court made under this Ordinance shall not have any force or effect until they have been approved by the Governor in Council and confirmed by resolution of the Legislative Council.

3. All rules of court made under the Principal Ordinance and in force at the commencement of this Ordinance shall remain in force and be liable to be amended or rescinded as though they had been made, approved and confirmed under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.
