AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant
of a pension to Mr. John Rollin Elijah Warner.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the John Rollin Elijah Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance and the Provident Fund Ordinance, it shall be lawful to grant a pension to Mr. John Rollin Elijah Warner under the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance as if at the date of his retirement on the 6th December, 1941, he had been serving as teacher in full time service in a school, and it shall further be lawful, for the purpose of computing such pension (but for no other purpose) to take into account the said Mr. Warner's service with the Government of the Colony as School Attendance Officer as if such service had been service in the capacity of teacher in full time service in a school.

Passed in Council this sixteenth day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
