AN ORDINANCE to amend the Arima Corporation
Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 11.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

Commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Arima Corpora- Short title.
tion (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943.

2. Subsection (2) of section 16 of the Arima Corporation Ordinance, as amended by the Arima Corporation (Amendment), Ordinance, 1942, is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“(2) (a) The reasonable travelling and other expenses incidental to the office of Mayor shall be paid out of the ordinary revenues of the Corporation: Provided that such expenses shall not in any mayoral year exceed such sum as the Governor in Council may by order from time to time direct.

(b) For removing doubts, it is declared that any such order shall, unless otherwise stated therein, be deemed to have been in operation as from the commencement of the mayoral year during which the order was made.”

Passed in Council this twenty-first day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
