AN ORDINANCE to amend the Governor's Emoluments
Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 1.

[1st January, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Governor's Short title,
&c. Emoluments (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be
read as one with the Governor's Emoluments Ordinance Ch. 9. No. 1.
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come
into force on the 1st January, 1943.

Section 2 of
the Principal
Ordinance
repealed and
replaced.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section :—

"Emoluments
of the
Governor.

2. The emoluments attached to the office of Governor of the Colony shall consist of—

- (a) salary at the rate of nineteen thousand eight hundred dollars per annum, and
- (b) duty allowance at the rate of six thousand six hundred dollars per annum."
