AN ORDINANCE to amend the Rent Restriction
Ordinance, 1941.

[18th November, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rent Restriction Short title
and construction.
(Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be read
and construed as one with the Rent Restriction Ordinance, No. 13 of 1941.
1941, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 5 of
the Principal
Ordinance
amended.

2. Subsections (5) and (6) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby repealed and replaced by the following :—

“(5) The Governor may appoint a Secretary and an Assistant Secretary to any Board and any such other officers as to him may seem necessary.

(6) The members, Secretaries, Assistant Secretaries and other officers of the Boards shall receive such remuneration, if any, as the Governor may generally or specially direct.”

Section 6 of
the Principal
Ordinance
amended.

3. Subsection (8) of section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words “or Assistant Secretary” after the word “Secretary” in the said subsection.
