AN ORDINANCE to provide for the payment to Dudley Ernest Best on his retirement from the Public Service of the Colony of a gratuity and reduced annual allowance under regulations 22 and 23 of the Pensions Regulations, 1932.

[18th November, 1943.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dudley Ernest Best (Gratuity and Annual Allowance) Ordinance, 1943. Short title.

2. It is hereby declared that it shall be lawful to grant Payment to Mr. Dudley Ernest Best of gratuity and reduced annual allowance. to Dudley Ernest Best (who was an artizan foreman in the Public Works Department of the Colony and who retired from the Public Service on the 30th of September, 1940, on

the ground of ill-health), with effect from the date of his retirement, the gratuity and reduced annual allowance to which he would have been entitled under regulations 22 and 23 of the Pensions Regulations, 1932, if—

- (a) he had duly exercised the options provided for in the said regulation 23 and in paragraph (b) of section 25 of the Pensions Ordinance, 1934; and—
- (b) section 11 of the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, had not been passed.
