AN ORDINANCE to amend the Immigration (Restriction)  
Ordinance.

[12th August, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration  
(Restriction) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be  
read as one with the Immigration (Restriction) Ordinance  
hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the following for paragraph (h) thereof:—

“(h) any person who from information or advice which in the opinion of the Governor-in-Council is reliable information or advice is deemed by the Governor-in-Council to be an undesirable inhabitant of or visitor to the Colony;”

3. Section 28 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby re-numbered as subsection (1) and a new subsection (2) to the said section is hereby added as follows:—

“(2) The Governor-in-Council may make rules for the management, control, and discipline of any place appointed by the Governor under subsection (1) for the detention of persons, for the diet of persons detained therein, and for the punishment of persons detained therein for any offences committed by them against such rules.”

Passed in Council this thirtieth day of July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
